## Reminders:

- 1) Please read through the content and requirements of the activities.
- 2) Each class admits 15-20 students. The school will try the best to arrange a class for students according to their prioritizations. If there are too many or too few applications for a particular class, the school will have the final decision.
- 3) Course fees are set with reference to the minimum class size, i.e. 15. If there are more than 15 participants, the fee will be readjusted.
- 4) The tentative course arrangement is:  
S1 and S3 activities will be held between October and November, 2009.  
S2 and S4 activities will be held between January and April, 2010.  
Talks and visits will be organised within the period to broaden the horizon of students.
- 5) Students must take part in one activity and comply with all the arrangements. Attendance is compulsory.
- 6) All participants must follow the instructions of teachers. They have to finish all assignments such as reports, presentations and display works as designated. Teachers-in-charge of the course will notify participants of further details.
- 7) Performance of students in the course will be evaluated by instructors or teachers-in-charge.
- 8) Results of the course selection as well as details of the courses including venues, dates, and times will be announced in a notice in September of the new school year. Fees will also be collected at that time.
- 9) In order to ensure that every student can enjoy learning experiences outside school, the “ Hong Kong Jockey Club Life-wide Learning Fund ” is jointly set up by the Hong Kong Jockey Club and the “ School-based After-school Learning and Support Programmes ” of the Education Bureau.
