<b>Theme-based Activities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• More than 10 different OLE courses</li> <li>• Each course: 9-12 hours, i.e. 6-8 activity lessons and 90 minutes per lesson</li> <li>• Each student is required to participate in at least one course</li> <li>• The courses are co-organized with external organizations</li> <li>• Teachers-in-charge are responsible for the administration matters</li> </ul>
<b>Seminars / Talks</b>	2-3 times yearly
<b>Co-curricular activities (CCA)</b>	Regular activities
<b>Special events</b>	Athletics Meet, Swimming Gala, Singing Contest, etc.
