Guidelines for S6 Admission (2010-2011) – For Internal Students

A) Application Procedures

4 August 2009 (Wednesday) (Stage I)

- (1) The application forms will be given out at the time of distribution of HKCEE results.

You have to complete 2 separate forms for the classes you would opt for as your **1st choice (green form)** and **2nd choice (yellow form)** in your application. You are reminded to write tidily when you fill in the application forms.

- (2) The application form(s), duly completed and checked, should be submitted to the teachers-in-charge during **9:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon in person or by authorisation.** Late Application will **NOT** be considered unless under special circumstances.
- (3) **Students who wish to apply for S6 admission must stay in school and wait for the results of admission for Stage I. Registration of successful S6 applicants and confirmation of their choice of subjects is expected to be accomplished before 11:00 a.m.** A list of students admitted to S6 will be displayed in the 8/F Playground in the meantime.
- (4) Registration of successful S6 applicants in Carra Hall:
- Tong Fai (HK\$470.00) should be paid by cash or by cheque made payable to ‘Raimondi College’. Write your name and class at the back of the cheque. Places will not be reserved for those who fail to pay.
 - **Successful applicants must submit the S6 Admission Slip which is attached to the Results Slip. Under no circumstances should the Admission Slip be returned.**
- (5) Applications for remission of Tong Fai will be available in September 2010.

5 August 2010 (Thursday) (Stage III)

- (1) A second list of students admitted to S6 will be displayed in the 8/F Playground at 4:00 p.m.

Note : An ASL (Advanced Supplementary Level) subject is equivalent to about half of an AL (Advanced Level) subject in its academic demand.

C) **Choice of Subjects**

(1) S6 students should take either 3 AL subjects OR 2 AL subjects + 2 ASL subjects OR 2 AL subjects + 1 ASL subjects in addition to Use of English and Chinese Language & Culture. Please indicate your choice of subjects in the application form at the time of application for S6 admission.

✓ *The choice of subjects will be confirmed before the registration of successful S6 applicants. Unless otherwise approved by the school, students are **NOT** allowed to change their subject combinations in September.*

✓ *Any appeal for the change of classes and/or subjects offered should be written by parents to Mr. K.H. Tam. The deadline for the appeal is **1 September 2010 (12:00 noon)**. Students will be notified of the results on or before 3 September 2010.*

(2) According to the regulations of the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority and due to constraints in timetabling, the following combinations of subjects are **NOT** allowed:

S6A: (a) History (AL) and History (ASL)
 (b) History (AL / ASL) and Principles of Accounts (AL)
 (c) Geography (AL) and Mathematics & Statistics (ASL)

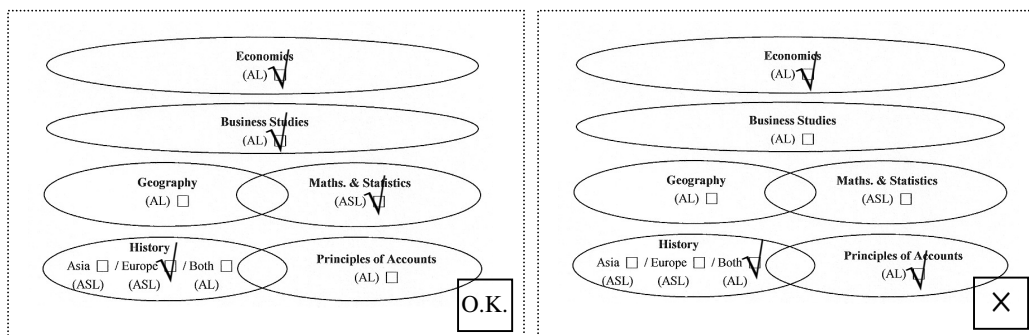
S6B: (a) Economics (AL) and Applied Mathematics (ASL)
 (b) Economics (AL) and Chemistry (ASL)

S6C: (a) Physics (AL) and Mathematics & Statistics (ASL)
 (b) Physics (AL) and Computer Applications (ASL)

✓ *For any TWO subjects that overlap in the Choice of Subjects diagrams of the Application Form, you can choose either ONE but NOT both.*

(3) **Split Class arrangements**

(a) **Economics (AL)**

- Maximum number of students from S6A & S6B = 30
- Priority will be given to S6A students. Maximum number of students from S6B = 10
- A grade D or above in Economics in HKCEE is required

(b) **Principles of Accounts (AL)**

- Maximum number of students from S6A = 15
- Maximum number of students from S6B = 15
- A grade E or above in Principles of Accounts in HKCEE is required.

(c) **Physics (AL)**

- Maximum number of students from S6B & S6C = 30
- Maximum number of places for S6C = 10
- Selection of students will be based on subject grade in Physics in HKCEE.

(d) **Mathematics & Statistics (ASL)**

- Maximum number of students from S6A & S6C = 30
- A grade D or above in Mathematics in HKCEE is required
