Part 1: Evaluation of the Effectiveness

1. Evaluation of achievement of the objectives: (e.g. reading culture of the whole school, students' reading attitude, book borrowing situation and students' engagement in reading activities)

New books were purchased to enrich the subject-based reading curriculum in order to enhance reading across the curriculum as well as students' reading interests and life-long habits. We also add new titles according to the moral and well-being of our students, interested as well as enhance the good characters, moral and attitudes. Each S.1- S.3 student has borrowed at least 10 items from the school library in this school year, as well as all junior students were arranged to visit the school library regularly during lessons of various subjects for participating in subject-based reading. All students were arranged to participated in reading schemes through different subjects too.

2. Evaluation of strategies: (e.g. implementing diversified and motivating activities to promote reading, reading across the curriculum and home school co-operation)

Students and teachers understood the importance of reading, strategies include subject-based library visits, 3-day book exhibition, D.E.A.R. activity for S.1 students, author's reading sharing, reading awards, World Book Day event, festive reading activities, assemblies on reading sharing, eRead platform enhancing English and Chinese reading. These strategies were effective and they will be continued next year. Morning reading periods has been resumed and more varieties of reading activities and programmes will be launched next year.
